

## CBCAN Explanation

The CBCAN notification system will allow emergency officials in Port Aransas to notify citizens (and visitors) of emergency situations and information. This may include evacuation notifications, missing children alerts, water outages, etc. The system relies on an internet self-registration and utilizes cell phones with text capabilities and email for the notifications.

You can register multiple phone numbers and email addresses and can determine when and how you receive the notifications. It is important to keep this registry current and you will periodically receive an email checking for any changes. When you register you will also be given an option to receive additional notices from the **City of Port Aransas** and the **City Parks and Recreation Department**. This is a City system and you will not receive any commercial solicitations or “spam”.

This system supplements, rather than replaces, other traditional communication methods used by emergency officials, both in person or through the use of other media such as television, radio or websites. We can NOT guarantee that notifications will be sent to, or be received by the intended recipient(s). You should not wait for or rely exclusively on a mass notification system call for evacuation direction if you think you are in immediate danger.*
