

Ordinance No. 2010-14

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE LANDSCAPING ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RULES APPLICABLE TO CHAPTER 10 HEALTH AND SANITATION

ARTICLE I. IN GENERAL

Sec. 10-1. Definitions.

*Weeds.* The word "weeds," as herein used, shall include all rank and uncultivated vegetable growth or matter which has grown to more than ~~eighteen (18)~~ twelve (12) inches in height, or which, regardless of height, is liable to become an unwholesome or a decaying mass or breeding place for mosquitoes or vermin.

Sec. 10-37. Grass, weeds, rubbish, brush, etc., prohibited on lots.

It shall be unlawful for any person who shall own or occupy any lots in the city do any of the following:

- (1) To allow rubbish, brush or any other unsightly, objectionable or unsanitary matter to accumulate on such lot or lots;
- (2) With the exception of dune vegetation located within one thousand (1,000) feet landward from mean high tide, to allow grass or weeds located within one hundred (100) feet of any building to exceed twelve (12) inches in height, unless an approved landscape permit allows otherwise;
- (3) To allow grass or weeds to grow over the edge of any sidewalk or curb in excess of twelve (12) inches;
- (4) To mow or cut any dune vegetation within an area of one thousand (1,000) feet landward from mean high tide, unless an approved dune permit allows otherwise.
